3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES Master craftsmen/mistresses in the road construction work trade have the professional, methodological, social and personal skills to manage and organise a road construction work company. In consideration of the customer requierements you can: develop a range of services and offer services, in particular: create plans, sketches, and technical drawings for traffic surfaces, earthworks, supply and disposal lines and installations, also using computer-aided systems, identify static systems, tender services from other trades based on orders, assess and evaluate offers, coordinate and monitor work processes with those involved in construction, perform layout and surveying work, differentiate building ground based on soil types, classes, and properties, assess usability, load-bearing capacity, workability, and contamination upon visual inspection; apply soil testing methods, evaluate test results, and initiate resulting measures, provide services, in particular: construct, secure, backfill, compact, and consolidate earthworks, excavations, and trenches; construct foundations and secure buildings; construct, repair, and rehabilitate structures, especially shafts, for supply and disposal lines; lay underground cables, supply and disposal lines, test for leakage, document results, control measures against scouring and erosion. carry out excavations in traffic surfaces and earthwork measures, restore superstructure, construct, rehabilitate, and repair surface layers, substructure, as well as edge reinforcements for roads, paths, and squares, execute and oversee track construction measures, especially track substructure and superstructure, as well as measures for drainage and water management for structures, properties, and traffic surfaces, execute and oversee construction site facilities and secure work sites on roads, particularly while considering workplace health and safety, execute and oversee park, sports, and playground construction, particularly taking into account drainage, landscaping, and the use of special surfaces, as well as hydraulic engineering measures, especially considering the landscape and surrounding structures, and renaturation, checking, documenting, handing over and invoicing services, in particular: conduct fault and defect searches, eliminate and evaluate faults, defects, and damages. In doing so, you make commercial, human resources and legally justified decisions, implement them and justify them. This includes in particular: plan, control and monitor work and business processes in a responsible position from an entrepreneurial perspective as well as ensure quality and sustainability,

4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THE CERTIFICATE

Master craftsmen/mistresses in the road construction work trade independently manage companies or take on management tasks in companies and business premises of the road construction work trade. In craft or industrial companies, they take on in addition to providing services one or more of the following activities:

- commercial and business management,
- technical management,
- organisation of vocational training and human resources development.
